In fact, the pros rank the 18th hole (No. 9 on the Gold Course) as one of the most challenging finishing holes on the tour. And well they should....at 465 yards with water on both sides of the tee shot, this par 4 plays uphill to a well bunkered green that slopes from back to front and must be judged correctly to post a good score.
